KITTEN VACCINATION SCHEDULE

6-8 weeks old:

- Comprehensive physical examination
- Feline Leukemia Virus/Feline Immunodeficiency Virus Tests
- Feline Rhino-Calici-Panleukopenia vaccination (1st)
- Feline Leukemia vaccination (1st)
- Fecal check for intestinal parasites
- Deworming

10-12 weeks old:

- Comprehensive physical examination
- Feline Rhino-Calici-Panleukopenia vaccination (2nd)
- Feline Leukemia vaccination (2nd)
- Fecal check for intestinal parasites
- Deworming if needed

14-16 weeks old:

- Comprehensive physical examination
- Feline Rhino-Calici-Panleukopenia vaccination- current for 1 year
- Feline Leukemia vaccination- current for 1 year
- Rabies vaccination- current for 1 year
- Fecal check for intestinal parasites
- Deworming if needed
- At this age your kitten is now old enough to be spayed (female) or neutered (male)
- Ask the veterinarian about microchipping your pet. Microchipping is a safe, simple and permanent form of pet identification.

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
